FREE NALOXONE KITS

Addiction Treatment Services (ATS) has free naloxone kits available free to the public. Naloxone is an opioid overdose reversal drug that can be purchased at pharmacies for anywhere from \$20-\$140. To pick up your own kit call ATS as 1-800-622-4810 or stop into their administrative office located at 1010 S. Garfield Ave. in Traverse City.
